## Summer Math Assignment for Students Entering Geometry in Grade 10

Tips for using [Mathxlforschool.com](http://Mathxlforschool.com):

1. If you don't remember how to do a problem, review the help tools that are located on the right side of each problem. Help tools may include: "Help me solve this," "Show me an example," "Video," or "Textbook."
2. To submit an answer, select "Check Answer."
3. If you get a question wrong, you can review your work and redo the problem until you are satisfied with your total score. If you enter a wrong answer three times, it will be marked wrong, but you can select "Similar Exercise" to try again. Similar Exercise will give you a new but similar problem. Keep trying until you are satisfied with your total score.
4. To save your work and continue at another time, click "Save" at the bottom of the assignment.
5. To get full credit on the assignment, you must show work for each question on paper and turn it in to your Geometry teacher in September.
6. There are 34 questions. Allow yourself time to complete them all.
