SPECIAL MEETING OF THE DISTRICT SCHOOL COMMITTEE, CONDUCTED ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 5, 2018 AT 5:30 P.M.

This meeting was called to accommodate the facilitation of the location of the Blue Hills Adult Basic Education Program temporarily while the school is in renovation. It is anticipated that this need will exist for School Year 2018-19.

1. At 5:35 p.m. the meeting was called to order by Chairman Marybeth Nearen. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. ROLL CALL:

- 3. CONSENT ITEMS
 - Adult Basic Education Grant Program Lease of Office and Classroom Space:

> ABE Program Rental

The Blue Hills Adult Basic Education program is currently seeking classroom and office space for its 2019 programs. The ABE program has found a space at The Village Shops in Canton located on the second floor of the 95 Washington Street Property. The property is approximately 2,214 square feet and consists of one large classroom area (to be divided into two classrooms), a second classroom space, office space, and a small kitchen area. The property is ADA compliant and has ample parking. Proposed total lease cost is \$34,981.20 and does not include any utilities. The ABE grant will cover 60% of the rent and the district's continuing education revolving fund will cover the balance of the cost. The ABE program grant has funds set aside to cover moving costs. Any additional moving costs will be covered by the Continuing Education Revolving fund. Utilities will be covered by Continuing education Revolving Fund and are estimated to be approximately \$500 a month.

This is a one year deal and the ABE program will need to find a new space for next year. One option is to have them drop their day time classes and run only evening classes at BHR. The program was supposed to be using space at the state hospital in Canton this year through an intergovernmental agreement. That agreement never materialized and the ABE program was left looking for space at the 11th hour.

Following conclusion of discussions, questions and answers, Chairman Nearen accepted a motion from Member Kevin L. Connolly to authorize the administration to enter into and sign a lease for the ABE program, provided the lease has been reviewed and approved by legal counsel and does not exceed \$35,000 and one year in term. was seconded by Secretary Eric C. Erskine. Motion was taken to avote and it was **UNANIMOUSLY**

VOTED: to authorize the administration to enter into and sign a lease for the ABE program, provided the lease has been reviewed and approved by legal counsel and does not exceed \$35,000 and one year in term

A SECOND motion was accepted by Chairman Nearen from Member Kevin L. Connolly moved to authorize the administration to release one month's lease payment in the amount of \$2,915.10 upon execution of the lease and access to the space. Motion was seconded by Member Michael Franzosa. Motion was taken to a vote and **UNANIMOUSLY**

VOTED: to authorize the administration to release one month's lease payment in the amount of \$2,915.10 upon execution of the lease and access to the space.
